

# NORTHEASTERN LEADERSHIP TEAM



JOSEPH E. AOUN
President, Northeastern University

Joseph E. Aoun, a well-known higher education thought leader and renowned scholar in linguistics, is the seventh President of Northeastern University.

An internationally respected voice on the value of global and experiential education, President Aoun led the global expansion of Northeastern's signature co-op program, bringing experiential learning opportunities to 148 countries. During his tenure, the university has created a global university system spanning campuses across North America and the U.K., quadrupled external research funding to more than \$200 million in annual awards, hired more than 800 tenured and tenure-track faculty, and earned the designation of an R1 research institution.

President Aoun is the author of numerous articles and books, including "Robot-Proof: Higher Education in the Age of Artificial Intelligence" (MIT Press, 2017). In it, he confronts the need for colleges and universities to meet the challenges and opportunities of the complex digital economy. The book lays out a blueprint for higher education with three primary components: a new curriculum for the A.I. age; the case for experiential learning, the ideal delivery system for this new curriculum; and a call or higher education to place lifelong learning at the heart of the educational enterprise.



### **DIANE NISHIGAYA MACGILLIVRAY**

**Senior Vice President for University Advancement, Northeastern University** 

Diane Nishigaya MacGillivray is Senior Vice President for University Advancement at Northeastern University, where she oversaw the successful completion of the university's

largest ever campaign in 2017, which raised \$1.4 billion, setting a new a university record. Under Ms. MacGillivray's leadership, annual fundraising has increased from an average of \$20 million to an average of \$110 million, including securing a gift for the first named college at the university and a \$50 million donation for a second named college. Most recently, she was instrumental in attaining two \$100 million gifts to launch an advanced technology campus in Portland, Maine—one from David and Barbara Roux to create the Roux Institute, and a second from the Harold Alfond Foundation to provide scholarships and other resources for its students.

Ms. MacGillivray steers a University Advancement team that works closely with Northeastern leadership to develop and execute fundraising strategies that fuel the university's momentum. After coming to Northeastern, she implemented a strategic restructuring of the fundraising operation from a centralized model to a more effective hybrid structure and oversaw the creation of new initiatives such as the parent giving program, innovative alumni engagement programs, and Women Who Empower—a university-wide initiative grounded in the belief that diverse and inclusive communities empower a better world.



### RICHARD A. D'AMORE, DMSB'76, BOARD CHAIR

**Partner, North Bridge Venture Partners** 

Rich D'Amore has three decades of experience in the venture business and has been with North Bridge since the company's inception in 1994. Before co-founding North

Bridge, Mr. D'Amore spent 14 years at Hambro International Equity Partners, establishing the firm's Boston office. His investments have been split between early-stage projects and special situations. Before joining Hambro in 1982, he worked as a consultant at Bain and Company and was a Certified Public Accountant with Arthur Young and Company.

A dedicated supporter of higher education, Mr. D'Amore serves as chair of the Board of Trustees at Northeastern University, where he promotes innovation and research that can drive economic growth. He also served as campaign co-chair for the university's historic Empower campaign, which surpassed its original fundraising goal, raising \$1.4 billion for students, faculty, and research. He and Alan McKim, DMSB'88, propelled the campaign forward with a historic gift of \$60 million in 2012 to name the university's D'Amore-McKim School of Business.

Mr. D'Amore received a bachelor's degree from Northeastern, summa cum laude, in 1975. He also has an MBA from the Harvard University Graduate School of Business Administration, where he was a Baker Scholar.



# SUBODH CHANRAI, PNT'20, '23, TRUSTEE

**Group Executive Chairman, Chanrai Summit Group** 

Subodh Chanrai is Group Executive Chairman of the Chanrai Summit Group, a Singaporebased corporation. Mr. Chanrai also serves

as the Executive Chairman of Fareast Mercantile Co. International Limited, which engages in sales, supply chain, and distribution of branded products in the food, fast-moving consumer goods, and appliances industries in the West Africa region. He previously served as the Director of Tulsi Eye Hospital in Nashik, India, a family-sponsored charity, which provides free eye care to those in need.

Mr. Chanrai is an active member of the Young Presidents
Organization. He is the parent of a 2020 graduate of Northeastern's
College of Arts, Media and Design, and a 2023 D'Amore-McKim
School of Business graduate. He joined the Northeastern University
Board of Trustees in 2021.



### SATYAJIT DATTAGUPTA

**Chief Enrollment Officer, Special Advisor to the President, and Senior Vice Chancellor** 

Satya Dattagupta joined Northeastern as Chief Enrollment Officer and Senior Vice Chancellor in 2022. He also serves as Special Advisor the President and Senior Vice Chancellor. With a

background in computer science and more than two decades in progressive enrollment management, he brings a focused data-driven enrollment and recruitment approach to lead the university's growth.

Prior to joining Northeastern, Dattagupta was the Senior Vice President and Dean of Admissions for Enrollment Management and Graduate and Pre-College Strategy at Tulane University. He holds a Bachelor of Science and an MBA from Southwest Minnesota State University, where he was an international student, giving him a unique perspective on diverse global recruitment and enrollment efforts.

Dattagupta works closely with university colleagues, identifying strategies and opportunities to support the university's long-term enrollment growth, innovation agenda, and sustainability. He oversees departments responsible for student recruitment, pricing and financial aid, admissions, and enrollment marketing and communications.

Itai Boublil is the Co-founder and CCO of KNOTS, a generative Al finance employee. His journey involves working with global startups for over 20 years. Mr. Boublil has held various

C-level roles in SaaS, Impact, fintech, corporations, and nonprofits during the past 10 years, focusing on marketing, sales, commercial, and revenue operations. He has also held different advisory roles with social impact and climate change startups, using his knowledge to help young founders save our planet.

A three-time founder, Mr. Boublil's true passion lies in solving complex problems. With KNOTS, his team took on the challenge of solving the finance team's main problem: how to shorten the time it takes to do manual work. To do so, the team built a generative Al finance employee that can shorten the time to do finance manual work from hours and days to no more than 30 seconds. He holds a B.S. in Business Administration from the D'Amore-McKim School of Business.

Spencer Fung is the Group Executive Chairman of Li & Fung Limited, a Hong Kongbased global supply chain management company. He previously served as Group

Chief Executive Officer until 2020. He joined Li & Fung in 2001 as a merchandiser, and has served in roles of increasing responsibility during his tenure.

Mr. Fung also serves as a Director of the Victor and William Fung Foundation. He previously worked at PwC in Boston and co-founded HelloAsia.com in 1999. He has been an Independent Non-Executive Director of Swire Properties, and is a member of the Young Presidents' Organization–Hong Kong Chapter. He is a member of the General Committee of the Hong Kong Exporters' Association. Mr. Fung earned an AB in Economics from Harvard College and holds an MS/MBA from Northeastern University's Professional School of Accounting. He joined the Northeastern Board of Trustees in 2013.



### AMBASSADOR JONATHAN KAPLAN

Ambassador Jonathan Kaplan is a prominent executive, entrepreneur, and philanthropist whose career has spanned numerous industries. He was the Co-founder and Chair of EducationSuperHighway, a U.S.-based

nonprofit organization that brought high-speed internet to more than 49 million children in K-12 classrooms nationwide. Professionally, Ambassador Kaplan is best known for founding Pure Digital Technologies and inventing its revolutionary Flip video camera. In 2009, Cisco bought Pure Digital Technologies, and Kaplan became Senior Vice President and General Manager of its Consumer Products Division.

Ambassador Kaplan was also the founding CEO of the Melt, a chain of fast-casual restaurants. Previously he was President and CEO of Sega.com and he was the founder and CEO of FamilyWonder, an entertainment and technology company. Ambassador Kaplan was named Northern California 2010 Entrepreneur of the Year by Ernst & Young, and was named by Business Week among the Most Influential People on the Web in 2008. He earned a BS from Carnegie Mellon University.



**CHRIS LEE**Assistant Chief Executive at National Gallery
Singapore

Chris Lee is the Assistant Chief Executive at National Gallery Singapore. He leads a firstof-its-kind museum experience and services business unit, which integrates visitor

experience, innovation and technology, integrated marketing and communications, and business development to deliver a seamless, personalized, and elevated experience with art physically and digitally within and beyond the walls of the museum.

Mr. Lee joined the National Gallery in 2016 as Chief Marketing Officer, where he successfully championed an audience-centric approach to help raise the gallery's profile locally and internationally, consistently overachieving the museum's goals in visitorship and revenue growth. Online visitorship doubled to 2.3 million post pandemic, and onsite visitorship has recovered close to prepandemic levels.

Mr. Lee also led a large cross-divisional team from 2019 to 2022 to radically redesign the museum into a new multimodal, decentralized ticketing and seamless experience. He continues to helm innovation of the art, museum, and work experience, collaborating with the curatorial and programming teams. He holds a bachelor's degree in mathematical and management studies from Brunel University in West London.



NICHOLAS A. NASH

Managing Partner and Co-founder of Asia

Managing Partner and Co-founder of Asia Partners

Prior to Asia Partners, Nicholas Nash was the Group President of Sea, a \$30 billion company and the largest internet firm by market capitalization across Southeast Asia. Mr. Nash

led Sea's landmark initial public offering on the New York Stock Exchange, which raised \$989 million of primary capital, the largest ever U.S. IPO of a technology company from Southeast Asia.

Mr. Nash joined Sea after more than a decade with General Atlantic (GA), most recently as the co-founder and head of its Southeast Asia business. Three of Mr. Nash's successful investments while with GA, namely Genpact, QTS, and Sea, became multi-billion dollar publicly traded companies. Prior to GA, Mr. Nash was a management consultant with McKinsey & Company in New York.

Mr. Nash is a member of the global Kauffman Society for leadership in venture capital, a member of the Young Presidents Organization in Singapore, a board member of Endeavor Indonesia, and a board member of the Yong Siew Toh Conservatory of Music at the National University of Singapore. He has also served as a board member of A\*Cellerate, the deep-tech commercialization effort of Singapore's government research institutes.



**JACQUELINE POH** 

Managing Director of the Singapore Economic Development Board

Jacqueline Poh is the Managing Director of the Singapore Economic Development Board, known as EDB. She was previously the Deputy Secretary in the Prime Minister's Office

Strategy Group. She was also the founding Chief Executive of the Government Technology Agency of Singapore, and Managing Director of the Infocommunications Development Authority.

Ms. Poh has held key positions in the Ministry of Manpower, the Ministry of Finance, and the Ministry of Defence. She is an alumna of the University of Oxford, the University of Cambridge, INSEAD (MBA), and Stanford University. She currently sits on the boards of SingHealth, the Singapore Institute of Technology, and the Agency for Science, Technology and Research. She is the Chairperson of the DesignSingapore Advisory Board and a member of the Young Presidents' Organisation.



# JEAN-PASCAL TRICOIRE, PNT'22, '23, '26, TRUSTEE

### **Chairman of Schneider Electric**

Jean-Pascal Tricoire is Chairman of Schneider Electric, where he served as Chief Executive Officer until May 2023. He serves as Co-Chairman of the France-China Business

Council, is a director of the worldwide board of the United Nations Global Compact, and is a United Nations #HeForShe Corporate IMPACT champion working with other heads of state, universities, and companies to advance gender equality. He is also an Independent Director of Qualcomm.

Since 2019, Mr. Tricoire has been a member of the International Business Council of the World Economic Forum. He earned his MEng in Electronic Engineering from ESEO in 1985, as well as an MBA from Emlyon Business School in 1986. He is the parent of 2022 and 2023 College of Science graduates, and an undergraduate student. He joined the Northeastern Board of Trustees in 2019.

Minister of Tourism and Creative Economy of the Republic of Indonesia

Sandiaga Salahuddin Uno is an Indonesian businessman and politician who was appointed Minister of Tourism and Creative

Economy of the Republic of Indonesia by the President of the Republic of Indonesia in December 2020. Previously, Dr. Uno was elected as Vice Governor of Jakarta and served from October 2017 to August 2018. He ran as a candidate for the Vice President of the Republic of Indonesia in the 2019 election.

Dr. Uno is one of Indonesia's most prominent young entrepreneurs, and he is active in the Indonesian business communities. He is the co-founder of PT Saratoga Investama Sedaya Tbk., the first and the biggest publicly listed active investment company in Indonesia; he served as a President Director from 2004–2015. He has led the investment firm to have a solid track record of profitable investments across key sectors of the Indonesian economy.

Dr. Uno has passion for empowering young entrepreneurs, creating support in small to medium enterprises, and giving microloans to thousands of Indonesians. Since 2005, he has been active as a social entrepreneur and serves as Chairman of several well-known associations and foundations in Indonesia. He obtained a doctoral degree in management from Universitas Pelita Harapan (Indonesia). He also holds an MBA from George Washington University (U.S.) and a BA, summa cum laude, from Wichita State University (U.S.).

Calvin Wong is the CEO of Southeast Asia and Senior Vice President of Asia for Universal Music Group (UMG), a newly created position he ascended to in 2019. The appointment

came alongside a strategic expansion of operations and infrastructure within Singapore, which became the main headquarters for UMG activity within the region.

An accomplished leader and marketing expert with more than 30 years of experience within the Asian music industry, Mr. Wong joined UMG from Warner Music Group, where he most recently held the position of UMG's President of Southeast Asia, Hong Kong, and Korea, and Executive Vice President of Marketing. Prior to joining Warner Music in 1998, he held several regional positions at EMI.

Mr. Wong leads UMG's regional operations across Indonesia, Malaysia, Philippines, Singapore, Thailand, Vietnam, and Indochina. In addition, she is a founding member of the Maternal and Infant Trade Association of Singapore, supporting Singaporean entrepreneurs in the mother and baby industry.
